NOW, THEREFORE, if the said principal shall faithfully perform his duties as a warehouseman in accordance with the provisions and requirements of said Act entitled, "An Act to regulate the business of storing personal property for a compensation and to repeal an Act named therein", approved June 27, 1935, in force July 1, 1935, as amended, the rules and regulations adopted by the Department pursuant to the provisions of said Act, and an Act entitled, "An Act in regard to warehouse receipts" approved May 29, 1907, in force July 1, 1907, as amended and shall provide for and promptly pay any judgment recovered by any person by reason of any loss of or damage to property stored with said principal, then the obligations aforesaid shall not be enforceable.

Regardless of the date upon which this bond may be executed, said bond shall be and remain in full force and effect from _____, until canceled.
