

**CRIMINAL JURISPRUDENCE ACT (DISEASED ANIMALS AT LARGE)**

**575/258. Allowing diseased sheep, etc., to run at large**

§258. Any person who shall hereafter knowingly and willfully bring or cause to be brought into this state any sheep or other domestic animals infected with contagious disease, or who shall knowingly and willfully suffer or permit sheep or other domestic animals infected with contagious disease to run at large, shall be guilty of a petty offense, and shall be liable in a civil action for all damages occasioned thereby.
