

**CIVIL ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF ILLINOIS (PART 4.5)**

AN ACT in relation to the civil administration of the State government, and to repeal certain acts therein named. Laws 1917, p. 2, approved March 7, 1917, eff. July 1, 1917.

**620/42. Title and interest to state fair grounds shall succeed to State**

§ 42. The people of the State of Illinois shall succeed to all the right, title and interest of the Illinois Department of Agriculture in and to the State fair grounds, and to all lands, buildings, money, unexpended appropriations or other property connected therewith.
