

Summary of IDA Response to Pesticide Incidents

December 9, 2010

November 9, 2010 – Near Williamsville in Sangamon County. Mechanical equipment failure involving Brandt Consolidated. Approximately 850 gallons of a mixture of water with glyphosate and 2,4-D were spilled. A nearby stream, Wolf Creek, was impacted. Approximately 30,000 gallons of contaminated water were captured and contaminated soil has been excavated. The water has been land-applied and a request for land application of the soil is anticipated.
