

IDA INCIDENT REPORT

(MARCH 2012- JUNE 12, 2012)

Ryco Ag Products – April 21, 2012 – Kinderhook (Pike Co.): Tender wagon rolled over near the intersection of IL Hwy. 96 and 287th Ave. An estimated 200-300 gallons of a mixture of 28% UAN solution and Guardsman Max herbicide was released in a dry tributary of Hadley Creek. Pooled liquids were recovered and impacted soil was excavated. IEPA and IDA responded.

Gateway FS, Inc. – April 23, 2012 – Breese (Clinton Co.): A leak in a hose caused the release of approximately 2 gallons of a mixture of water and Roundup herbicide. The release occurred on a city street. Recovery of the spill was handled by facility personnel.

Shipman Elevator Co. – April 25, 2012 – Shipman (Macoupin Co.): A farmer left a valve on his truck in the open position resulting in the release of approximately 5 gallons of Outlook herbicide and 15 gallons of Cornerstone herbicide at the Shipman Elevator Co. location. Agricultural limestone was used to absorb the spill. Approximated 16 tons of limestone and soil was excavated. A Land Application Authorization was issued by IDA for the land application of the recovered material.

Roadside spill – April, 2012 – Tazewell Co.: Spill of a fertilizer/pesticide mixture into Prairie Creek resulting in the recovery of approximately 40,000 gallons of water from the creek. IEPA responded.

Crop Production Services – May 6, 2012 – Paris (Edgar Co.): A broken hose caused the release of a mixture of Matador herbicide, Sharpen herbicide, Durango herbicide, and 32% UAN solution onto County Road 1225 near Paris. Facility personnel used absorbent materials to recover the spill.

Dale McCoy – May 15, 2012 – Altamont (Effingham Co.): A hose fitting broke loose causing the release of approximately 50 gallons of a mixture of water and Acumen herbicide onto approximately one-half mile of roadway (300th Ave. south of Altamont). Altamont Fire Dept. and County Road Supervisor responded.

Unknown Party – May 22, 2012 – Mt. Carroll (Carroll Co.): Lee Heeren of IEPA (Rockford) reported a suspicious staining of the roadway at the intersection of IL Rt. 78 and IL Rt. 64 in Mt. Carroll that appeared to be due to the release of an unknown herbicide/fertilizer mixture release.

Sun Ag Supply – May 29, 2012 – Pekin (Tazewell Co.): A tender truck containing a mixture of Roundup PowerMax herbicide and water overturned into an intermittent stream near 3611 Sheridan Road in Pekin. It was determined that 98 gallon of the mixture containing 1.9 gallons of Roundup was released. Dry dams were constructed to prevent migration of product. IEPA-ERU ordered the flushing of the spill area and the recovery of the resulting flush water. IEPA and IDA responded.

Brandt Consolidated, Inc. – June 3, 2012 – Williamsville (Sangamon Co.): Release of anhydrous ammonia from storage tank during attempted theft. Vapor plume impacted a nearby corn field. Fire Dept. applied 50 gallons of water to a pool of product. Facility sampled impacted areas and will excavate soils if nitrogen levels are found to be above cleanup objectives. IEPA-ERU responded.
