

INCIDENT REPORT

(MARCH 14, 2013 – JUNE 4, 2013)

St. Clair Service Co. – April 4, 2013 – Freeburg (St. Clair Co.): The incident involved the release of 350 gallons of 28% UAN fertilizer solution in a wheat field during application. The field is located near the intersection of Illinois Highway 15 and Ross Lane, east of Freeburg. The front wheels came off the application equipment causing the release. The RP indicated that the spill was contained within the field of application and that the soil impacted soil was excavated the same day and transported to the Belleville facility. The soil was stored under a plastic cover until it could be disposed of. IDOA personnel investigated on April 8, 2013.

Effingham Equity – April 5, 2013 – (Clark Co.): The incident involved the release of approximately 15 tons of DAP and Potash dry fertilizer from an overturned transport truck into a roadside ditch. The release occurred at the corner of Illinois Highway 1 and Dennison Road, north of Marshall, IL. The RP recovered the spilled product, using a grain vacuum to recover the material that could not be recovered by shovel. The affected area was then reseeded. IDOA personnel investigated on April 8, 2013.

Crop Production Services – April 10, 2013 – Penfield (Vermilion Co.): The incident involved the release of approximately 12.5 tons of Potash from an overturned transport truck into a roadside ditch. The release occurred at 2550 170 E Rd., Penfield, IL. The RP recovered the spilled product. IDOA personnel investigated on April 15, 2013.

The Doc Care of Trees – April 17, 2013 – Libertyville (Lake Co.): The incident involved the release of less than 50 gallons of Pure Spray Horticultural Oil from truck mounted spray tank. The incident occurred at 180 Adler Dr. in Libertyville. The RP hired a private company to perform the cleanup.

Earlybird Feed and Fertilizer – May 14, 2013 – Eureka (Woodford Co.): The incident involved the release of 509 gallons of a mixture of 28% UAN fertilizer solution, ammonium sulfate, Atrazine, Stalwart C, Fanfare, and 2,4-D from an overturned transport truck into a roadside ditch on 4H Road near Eureka. The RP contained and recovered the spilled product and excavated the impacted soil. IDOA personnel investigated on May 20, 2013.

Clarke Aquatic Services – May 20, 2013 – Antioch (Lake Co.): The incident involved drift from a pond treatment at Herrin Harbor in Antioch. The pond was treated with a mixture of Hydrothol 191 and Tribute.
