

INCIDENT REPORT

(MARCH 4, 2015 – JUNE 3, 2015)

Landmark Services Cooperative – April 18, 2015 – Durand (Winnebago Co.): The incident involved a pinhole leak in a bulk liquid fertilizer storage tank causing a release of 28% UAN solution over the containment structure wall. Approximately 150 gallons of liquid fertilizer was released. The facility has excavated soil in the affected area.

Westridge Agri-Service – April 22, 2015 – Tuscola (Douglas Co.): The incident involved the release of a field mix of 24 gallons of Bicep II Magnum pesticide (atrazine and metolachlor) in 1475 gallons of water onto the facility property. The trailer carrying the tank came unhooked as vehicle was exiting the loading operational containment structure causing the release. The facility pumped standing liquid into storage tanks. Affected soil and gravel pack areas were excavated to a depth of approximately 8"-12". Excavated material was stored under cover. IEPA and Department of Agriculture representatives observed the clean-up procedures. The facility has hired a contractor and will enter IEPA's voluntary site remediation program.

Jerry Douglas – April 30, 2015 – Rossville (Vermilion Co.): The incident involved the release of approximately 100 gallons of Round-up herbicide into a roadside ditch in rural Vermilion Co. Product was release from the transport tank when the driver of the vehicle was making a turn. The facility proposed to remove affected soil from the ditch, replace with clean soil, and reseed the area.

Mont Eagle Mills – May 1, 2015 – Lawrenceville (Lawrence Co.): The incident involved the release of 200 gallons of Lumax herbicide (atrazine, metolacholor, and mesotrione) and 178 gallons of Touchdown herbicide (glyphosate) onto a farm driveway and roadside ditch in rural Lawrence Co. The RP performed excavation of the affected soil and gravel pack. Approximately 10"-12" of gravel and 2 feet of soil were excavated. Recovered soil and gravel stockpiles were covered with plastic.
