100 gallon spill – area excavated – disposal inconclusive at this point

- 1,450 gallons Bicep II Magnum
- Excavated: further excavation needed. Work to be continued the week of June 1st

All but 150 gallons of the 1,600 gallons of water/Bicep mix was released onto the facility grounds. Efforts to recover the liquid yielded 2,000 gallons, apparently there was water in the low area where the liquid flowed. None of the tank mix left the property. All contaminated soil has been recovered and will be disposed of in a landfill.
