

INCIDENT REPORT

(JUNE 4, 2015– AUGUST 31, 2015)

Clin/Wash Ag Service – May 28, 2015 – Centralia (Marion Co.): The incident involved the release of approximately 7 tons of potash dry fertilizer from a transport truck during a vehicle accident. The Spill occurred at the intersection of State Route 37 and Shattuc Road near Centralia. The facility recovered the dry spillage from the grass area near the roadside and returned it to the dry fertilizer storage building at the Carlyle facility

United Prairie, LLC – June 16, 2015 – Tolono (Champaign Co.): The incident involved a release of approximately 5,000 gallons 32% from a bulk liquid fertilizer storage tank. The facility was performing scheduled maintenance on one of their empty bulk liquid fertilizer storage tanks. During a break in the maintenance activity, a valve was mistakenly opened allowing liquid fertilizer from one of their filled storage tanks to drain into the tank being worked on. The manhole cover had been removed from the tank and product reached the level of the manhole and was released. The facility has performed excavation and recovery of impacted soil and is currently storing the recovered soil in an on-site building under roof on a concrete floor. The facility has submitted a request for the land application of the contaminated soil to the Department of Agriculture. The review of the said request is pending.
