

INCIDENT REPORT

(MARCH, 2016– JUNE, 2016)

Helena Chemical Company – April 17, 2016 – Wilmington (Will Co.): The incident involved the release of approximately 100-200 gallons of a tank mix of 32% UAN and Lexar herbicide from a pipe fitting failure on the spray application rig during transit. The incident occurred at the intersection of IL Rte. 53 and IL Rte. 102. Local authorities closed the intersection. The RP enlisted the services of a contractor to handle the cleanup.

Ag Tech Services, Inc. – April 24, 2016 – Sandwich (DeKalb Co.): The incident involved the release of approximately 100 gallons of UAN fertilizer solution due to a rollover of a semi-truck and trailer. The incident occurred at 3960 Somonauk Rd, north of Sandwich. The RP excavated affected soil, brought clean top soil to the site, re-graded and seeded the spill site.

Liquid Transport Co. – May 9, 2016 – Hull (Pike Co.): The incident involved the rollover of a semi-truck and trailer. The incident occurred on the northbound ramp from I-72 to I-172. The trailer was righted and no signs of a release of the herbicide (Halex) were observed. Local authorities, IEPA and IDoA responded.

Effingham Equity – June 13, 2016 – Montrose (Effingham Co.): The incident involved the release of approximately 500 gallons of 32% UAN fertilizer solution due to a rollover of an applicator tank. The incident occurred at the corner of CR 1950 and US Hwy. 40. The spill appeared to be confined to the roadside ditch and ran for a distance of approximately 300 feet. The RP recovered all standing liquid product and excavated affected soil from the ditch. All recovered product, rinsate, and soil was transported to the Montrose agrichemical facility. IEPA and IDoA responded.
