***TENTH AMENDMENT
TO THE
EMERALD ASH BORER INTERIOR QUARANTINE***

Pursuant to the Insect Pest and Plant Disease Act (505 ILCS 90/1 et seq.), the Director of Agriculture has determined that it is necessary to quarantine portions of the State in order to prevent the spread of a dangerous plant pest known as the EMERALD ASH BORER (*Agilus planipennis* Fairmaire). This plant pest, a highly destructive pest of trees, has been introduced into the State of Illinois and incipient infestations have been identified in the state.

The quarantine established by the Director of Agriculture on July 18, 2006, amended on November 9, 2006, January 12, 2007, April 27, 2007, July 19, 2007, November 5, 2008, April 13, 2010, October 26, 2010, November 10, 2011, and December 10, 2012 is hereby amended as follows:

Section III. Regulated Areas, shall read:


- “1. The entire Counties of Boone, Bureau, Carroll, Champaign, Clark, Coles, Cook, Cumberland, DeKalb, Dewitt, Douglas, DuPage, Edgar, Effingham, Fayette, Ford, Grundy, Henderson, Henry, Iroquois, Jo Daviess, Kane, Kankakee, Kendall, Knox, Lake, LaSalle, Lee, Livingston, Macon, Marion, Marshall, McHenry, McLean, Mercer, Moultrie, Ogle, Piatt, Putnam, Rock Island, Shelby, Stark, Stephenson, Vermillion, Warren, Whiteside, Will, Winnebago, and Woodford; and
2. Any other area within the State of Illinois where the presence of the Emerald Ash Borer (*Agilus planipennis* Fairmaire) is confirmed in the future.”

These amendments to the Quarantine shall be effective on or after this 1st day of **November 2013**. All other provisions of the original quarantine, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
